

Dedicated business jet terminal opens at KIX! Offering guests smoother experience with high level of privacy

Kansai Airports is delighted to announce that dedicated business jet terminal "Premium Gate \pm " -Tamayura-" for both international and domestic passengers will open in early June 2018 in the Terminal 2 Domestic area. Equipped with security checkpoint and CIQ (customs, immigration and quarantine), the new terminal also features a drop-off and pick-up area, car park, a meeting room, a reception desk and a lounge, all dedicated to business aviation passengers, who are currently using immigration facilities for general passengers in Terminal 1. The new facility, upon completion, will offer smoother processes as well as a high level of privacy to business jet travelers.


With globalization accelerating at a rapid pace, business jet services, now mainly popular in Europe and the U.S., are expected to increase in Asian countries.
