

British Airways to resume KIX-London flights for first time in 20 years

- Nonstop service on the route for first time in 10 years -

Kansai Airports is pleased to announce British Airways will offer four weekly flights between Kansai International Airport (KIX) and London, beginning April 1, 2019—a resumption of service after 20 years absence since 1998. This will provide direct connectivity from KIX to London for the first time in 10 years since Japan Airlines suspended its service in 2009. (This route will be a code share operation by British Airways and Japan Airlines)

Direct flights to London were pursued for many years by NKIAC¹ together with the business community, local governments and travel industry in the Kansai region. This effort has been passed on to Kansai Airports ever since it took over the airport operations in April 2016, in the form of a concession (grant of rights to operate government property) by Orix and VINCI. Marketing and promotional efforts have been stepped up utilizing our global aviation expertise. And finally, all of the efforts have borne fruit. We would like to thank all involved for their efforts in making this possible.

Foreign visitors to Japan from the UK doubled from 150,000 in 2011 to 310,000 in 2017. With Kansai set to host a series of international events such as next year's Rugby World Cup and G20 Osaka Summit, and 2021 World Masters Games Osaka, further demand for air travel from the UK and Europe is expected. The new flight service to London—the financial center of Europe and a popular tourist destination for Japanese—will cater to the outbound demand of both business and leisure travelers from Japan as well as help revitalize the economy in Kansai.

Kansai Airports will continue to offer a wide range of flight options including long-haul routes answering to customer needs as well as providing comfortable and enjoyable experience for all our passengers.





- Attractive events such as World Rugby 2019, Olympic and Palarinpic games are upcoming. These events will be a driving force to attract more tourists.


