

## KIX, ITAMI, KOBE February 2021 Traffic Report

- International passenger traffic decreased from the previous month as many countries tightened their border controls to prevent the spread of new variants of the coronavirus.
- The recovery rate of domestic flights and passenger traffic in February slowed down further compared to the previous month mainly due to the government's state of emergency extended in some regions, including three prefectures in Kansai, as well as the government's request to avoid nonessential travel.
- The number of international freighters continued to increase year-over-year due to a tight supply of cargo service caused by a decline in passenger flights.
