

KIX, ITAMI, KOBE July 2021 Traffic Report

- On international flights, passenger traffic remained limited due to the impact of enhanced border control measures as a preventive measure against novel coronavirus variants.
- In the Kansai region, the total number of domestic passengers at the three airports increased from last month to about 40% of two years ago due to the lifting of the state of emergency in the previous month and the long weekend in late July.
- International cargo flights have continued to perform well. In July, aircraft movements reached a record high since the airport's opening at 2,423. The international cargo volumes have exceeded the previous year's level for seven consecutive months since January 2021.

Kansai Airports was established by a consortium made up of VINCI Airports and ORIX Corporation as its core members.
