

## KIX, ITAMI, KOBE August 2021 Traffic Report

- On international flights, passenger traffic remained limited due to the impact of enhanced border control as a preventive measure against novel coronavirus variants.
- The total number of domestic flights at the three airports recovered to about 80% of 2019 partly due to flight increase during the Obon period. On the other hand, the number of passengers was about 40% of two years ago due to the spread of the variants and the state of emergency.
- International cargo aircraft movements have continued to perform well at over 2,000 per month. International cargo volumes have also exceeded the previous year's level for eight consecutive months since January 2021.
