

# Influence of KIX, ITAMI and KOBE affected by Typhoon No.21

Please find below the official report of the three Kansai airports affected by Typhoon No.21 (As of 9 p.m.) Updates are underlined.

Regular updates will be given to the media about the situation.

### ■ Kansai International Airport

#### In-waiting passengers

- Approximately 3000 people. (approx. 2500 people in Terminal 1, approx. 150 people in Terminal 2, and the rest in Aero Plaza and Hotels) are safe in the airport premises.
- <u>Domestic gate area and hotel banquet rooms are used to accommodate passengers in the best possible conditions.</u>
- Water, food and blankets have been distributed to all passengers. Airport staff is mobilized to attend their needs.
- Solutions are being investigated to allow passengers to return safely to the main island as soon as possible.
- Injured: <u>no updates.</u> One person slightly injured his arm during typhoon. Due to broken glass at Terminal 2 facility "Aero Plaza" (East side of the station).

#### Flooding:

- The whole area of Runway A (Terminal 1 side) and Apron are flooded. The depth of flooding is approximately 40~50 cm.
- · Terminal 1 underground Staff Area also flooded.
  - \*Terminal 1 passengers were not affected.
- Terminal 2 and Runway B were not affected.

#### Runway:

Both Runway A and B were closed from 12 p.m. Reopen time to be confirmed. No confirmation to reopen during Wednesday, Sep 5<sup>th</sup>.

#### Kansai Airport Bridge:

• Both Railway and cars are restricted. <u>Emergency vehicles can circulate.</u> Reopen time to be confirmed. <u>No confirmation to reopen during Wednesday, Sep 5<sup>th</sup>.</u>

#### Collision of Tanker: no updates

- Accident was announced by Japan Coast Guard at 14:40. No injuries. Details are to be confirmed.
- Pier (South side) is damaged.

#### Power Outage:

There was a blackout in Terminal 1 as well as Terminal 2 from 13:30.

# ■ Osaka International Airport

Operations have resumed but some effect will remain tomorrow, Wednesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>.

# ■ Kobe Airport

Operations have resumed but some effect will remain tomorrow, Wednesday, September 5<sup>th</sup>.
