

Planned runway closure at KIX due to upcoming Typhoon Trami

- From 11:00 am, September 30 through 6:00 am, October 1 -

To prepare for the possible impact of the upcoming Typhoon Trami, there will be a planned closure of runways at Kansai International Airport (KIX) from Sunday, September 30 through Monday, October 1. During the closure, no flight services will be offered.

In light of what we learned from the severe damages KIX sustained during and after Typhoon Jebi and in line with our motto of making safety and security a priority, we have decided to close both Runways A and B after making coordination with airport stakeholders including government agencies, airlines, transportation operators, shops and restaurants. We apologize in advance for the inconvenience and appreciate your understanding.

Please note that specific flight operations as well as transportation services to and from the airport during the planned closure duration will be determined by each operator.

For their own safety, we advise our airport guests not to come to the airport unless it is absolutely necessary. Thank you for your kind cooperation.

(1) Planned runway closure (Runways A and B)

From 11:00 am on Sunday, September 30 to 6:00 am on Monday, October 1

- The duration of the closure is subject to change depending on weather or other conditions. We will inform you in advance of any change to the closure duration.
- Please check with your airline to determine the status of your flight.
