



KIX Pharma Community to hold KIX Pharmaceutical Seminar

Kansai Airports today announced that KIX Pharmaceutical Seminar will be held in Tokyo on January 20, 2020, as part of KIX Pharma Community's¹ efforts to improve the quality of pharma logistics.

Established in partnership between Kansai Airports and international cargo handlers, KIX Pharma Community achieved IATA's CEIV Pharma² in June 2019, becoming the first airport community certified in Japan. The certification demonstrates that pharmaceutical handling operations meet international standards. And with all the community members being CEIV Pharma certified, the quality levels throughout the pharmaceutical supply chain at Kansai International Airport (KIX) have been greatly improved, enabling ever higher quality pharma cargo service for customers.

The upcoming seminar will feature a lecture on the benefits that the CEIV Pharma certification brings to the pharmaceutical industry, as well as the spread of the certification at airports around the world. The event will also include a workshop on pharmaceutical transport and a networking party that offers participants an opportunity to share their opinions and questions.
