

## KIX, ITAMI, KOBE February 2020 Traffic Report

- Affected by a slowdown in air travel demand caused by the outbreak of COVID-19, KIX saw suspension and reduced frequency of international passenger flights mainly on the Chinese routes.
- International passenger traffic dropped substantially from the previous year. In particular, the number of foreign passengers showed a sharp decline.
- Following the government's call for a voluntary ban on private and business trips, domestic passenger traffic has decreased significantly at all three airports since late February.
