

KIX, ITAMI, KOBE May 2020 Traffic Report

- Due to travel restrictions imposed by various countries amid the global spread of COVID-19, operations of international passenger flights were limited mainly to flying people back to their home countries. Consequently, aircraft movements and passenger traffic decreased on international routes.
- The number of domestic flights remained at the lowest level that matches minimum aviation demand, affected by the extended state of emergency as well as ongoing travel restrictions.
- Meanwhile, the number of international cargo flights continued to grow significantly to compensate for a supply shortfall caused by the decline in cargo volume transported on passenger flights.
