

# KIX, ITAMI, KOBE August 2020 Traffic Report

- Some international passenger flights have resumed since July. But as the COVID-19 pandemic continues on, growth in passenger traffic was limited.
- Domestic flights recovered to 80% to 90% of 2019 levels at all the three airports partly driven by increased traffic during the Bon holidays. Yet, passenger numbers were around 30% of last year's levels in part because of a rise in infections across the nation and authorities' requests for people to refrain from traveling during Bon.
- Year-on-year growth in international cargo flights continued into August amid tight supply caused by a decline in passenger flights.
