



Emergency drill to be held at KIX aircraft fueling facility

Kansai Airports will carry out an emergency exercise at Kansai International Airport (KIX) on November 16, 2020, simulating that a massive earthquake has affected the airport's aircraft fueling facility during the night.

The drill is held to ensure quick and effective responses to earthquakes, aiming to foster coordination between relevant organizations, enhance the response structure and raise awareness of disaster prevention.

Kansai Airports will continue to strive to ensure the safety of air travel for passengers and provide a secure environment for all airport users.
