

Kobe Airport to celebrate its 15th anniversary

- Anniversary and passenger appreciation events to be held -

Kansai Airports is pleased to announce that, in celebration of Kobe Airport's 15th anniversary on February 16, it will host an anniversary event in Kobe Harborland *Umie* and at Kobe Airport on March 20 and 21.

On the event days, Kobe Harbarland *Umie* will offer plenty of entertainment for everyone to enjoy, from children to adults. There will be various booths and workshops run by airlines as well as a digital stamp rally, in which participants who collect stamps at different locations will receive a small gift. Booths promoting local products and tourism will also be set up by the airport's destinations, including Hanamaki, a city in Iwate Prefecture which will be connected to Kobe from March 28. Meanwhile, at Kobe Airport, airport bus tours will be organized to take visitors to the areas that are usually off-limits to the public.

Furthermore, ahead of the anniversary event, five airlines operating at Kobe Airport will gather together to greet departing passengers on March 19 to express their gratitude to passengers using the airport over the past 15 years.
