With the opening of these new restaurants, we will be able to accommodate a wider variety of customers, including those who are flying, seeing off or picking up passengers, and staying late at night. The opening dates of the new stores will be announced as soon as they are determined.

Kansai Airports Group will continue to work with all stakeholders to enhance the functions of KIX, the gateway to the Kansai region that welcomes domestic and international passengers and will proceed with renovation work with safety and security as our top priority.

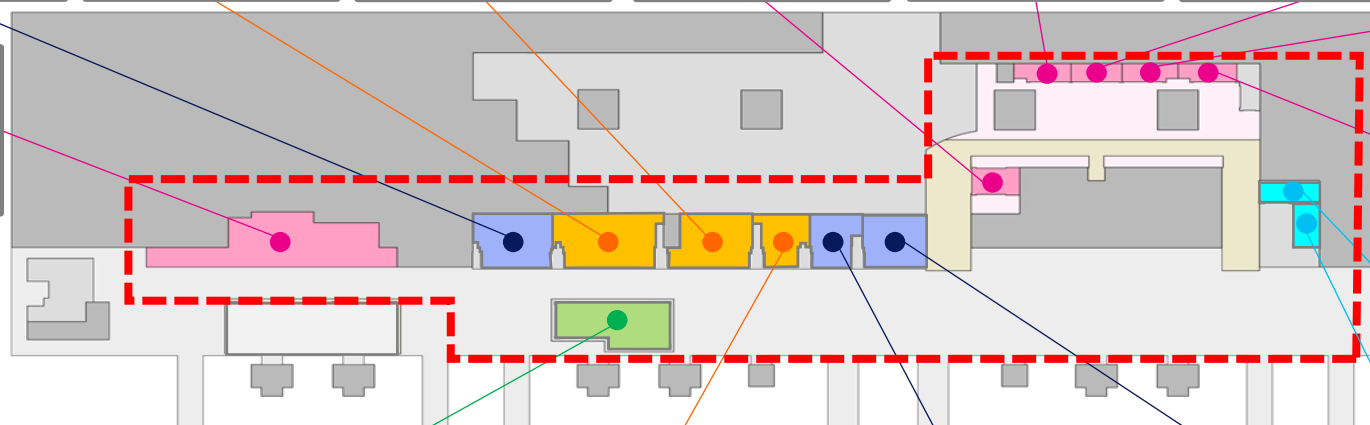

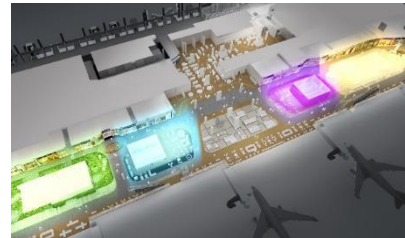

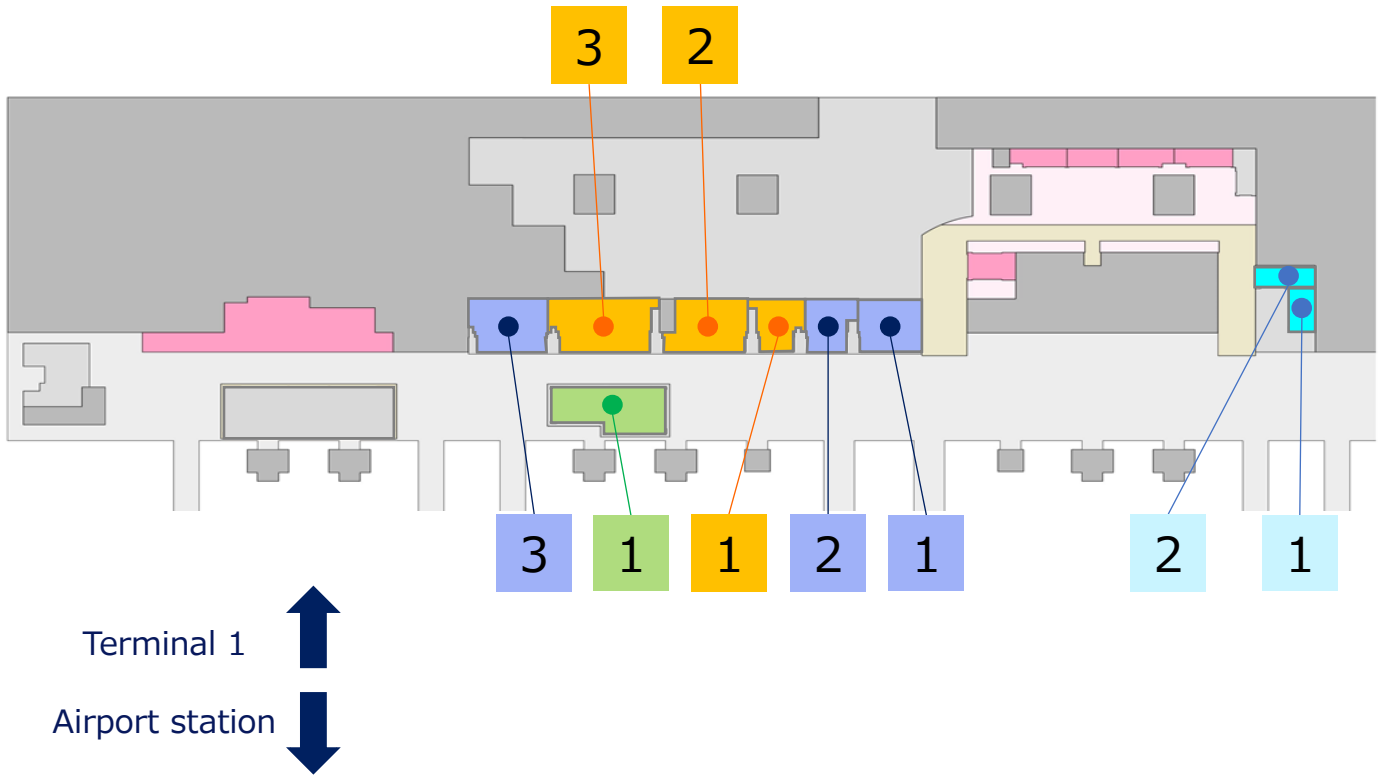
