Traffic Report for November 2023

-  The passenger traffic for international flights remained steady with non-Japanese and Japanese traffic at 99% and 57% of 2019 respectively, and overall passenger traffic for international flights was 85% of 2019.
-  The total passenger traffic for domestic flights of the three airports remained steady at 92% compared with 2019.
-  The international cargo movements were 82% compared to the previous year but remained high compared to pre-COVID-19 levels, at 142% of 2019. The international cargo volume was higher than the previous year's level for the first time in 17 months, at 106% of 2022.

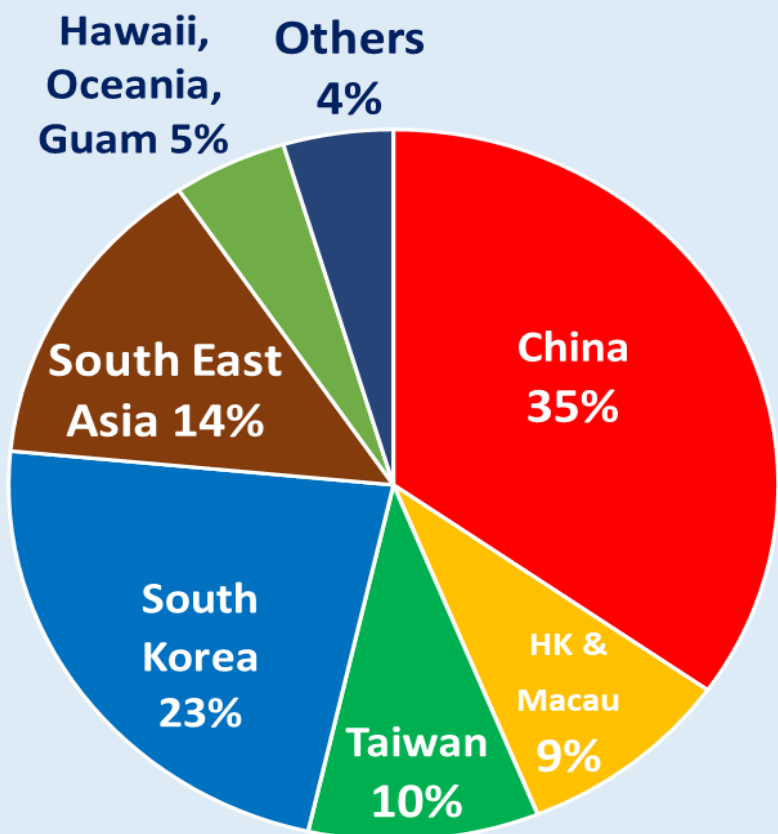

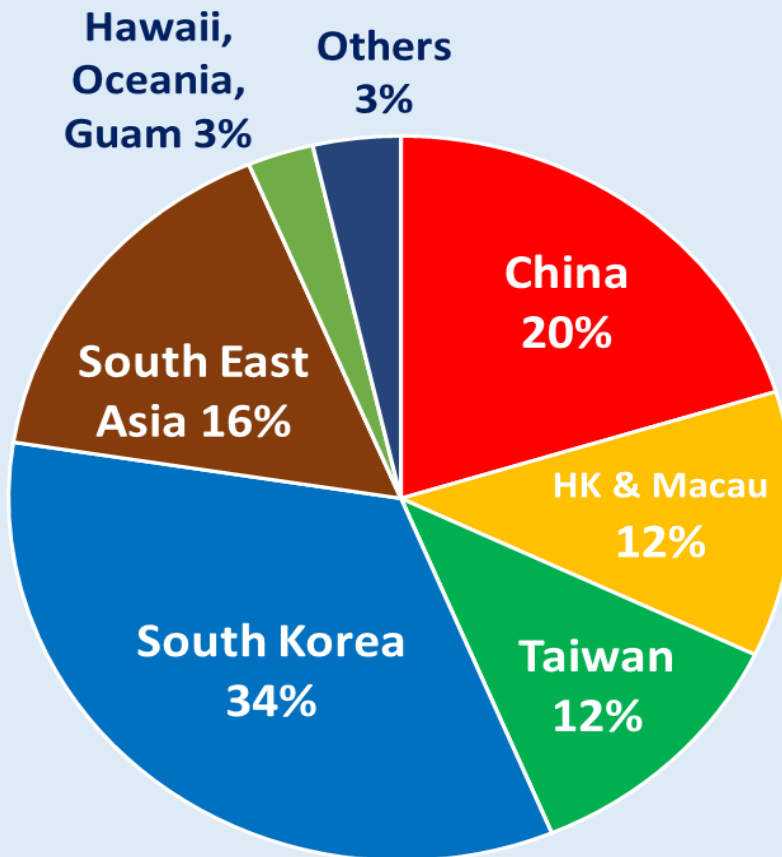

(Movements)

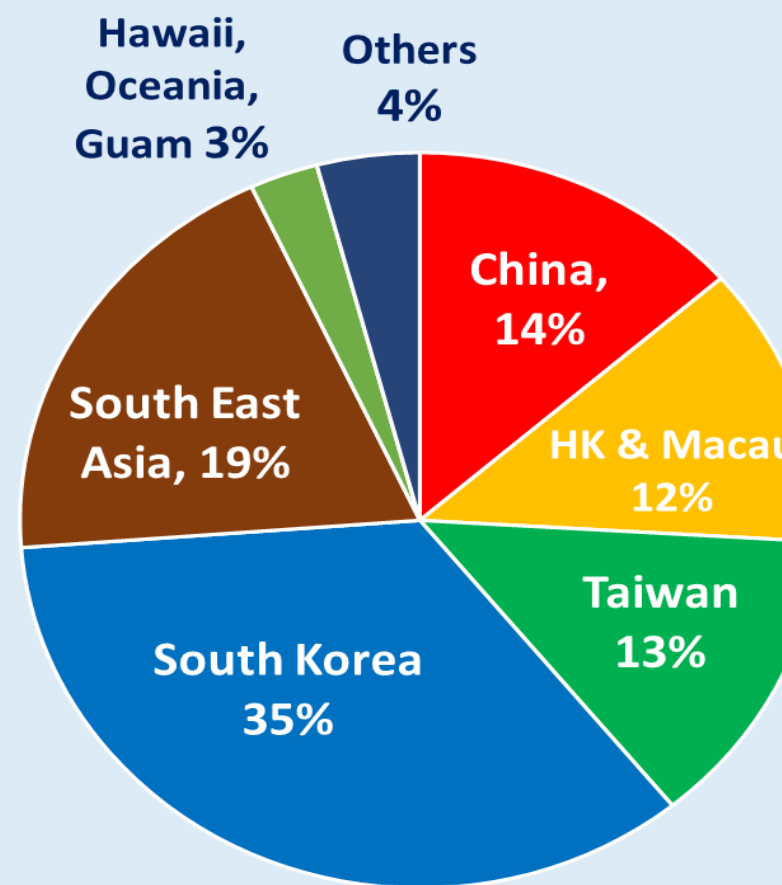
