# KIX / ITAMI / KOBE Traffic Report for March 2024

- The number of passenger traffic for international flights exceeded that of the 2019 pre-COVID levels for the second consecutive months, with the number of non-Japanese traffic at 105% vs. 2019. The number of Japanese traffic also continued to recover at 61% vs. 2019. The entire passenger traffic for international flights was 88% vs. 2019.
- ◆ The total domestic passenger traffic for the three airports was at 93% vs. 2019 and 94% year-on-year.
- The international cargo traffic was lower than the previous year both in ATM and cargo volume.

# KIX / ITAMI / KOBE FY2023 Traffic Report (April-March)

#### **○**ATM for KIX, ITM, and UKB

With the termination of Japanese government's border control in April 2023, the number of international ATMs has further recovered to 98,722 (\*1). The number of domestic ATMs at Kobe Airport reached a record high (\*2) of 34,670 in FY2023, partly owing to the increase in flights after deregulation in August 2019. The total ATMs at the three airports reached 221,787 at 99% yoy, which was lower than the previous year, but the second highest result (\*3). The international cargo ATMs reached 20,488 at 80% yoy, which was lower than the previous year, but it still remains high at 143% compared to FY2019.

- \*1...332% yoy, 75% compared to FY2019,
- \*2...The previous record high was 34,463 in FY2022.
- \*3...The highest record was 223,551 in FY2022.

#### Number of passengers for KIX, ITM and UKB.

The number of international passengers was the second highest (\*1), with non-Japanese passengers at 15.01 million (\*2). The number of domestic passengers remained stable at 3.44 million at Kobe Airport, which hit record high (\*3) in FY2023, and the total number of passengers at the three airports recovered to 97% from FY2019.

- \*1···The record high was 15,53 million in FY2018. \*2···102% compared to FY2019.
- \*3...The record high was 3.29 million in FY2019.






