KIX / ITAMI / KOBE Traffic Report for June 2025

- At KIX, the number of foreign passengers reached 112% year-on-year, while the number of Japanese passengers was 113% year-on-year. As a result, the total number of international passengers reached 2.23 million, or 112% year-on-year. At KOBE, the number of international passengers was 48,000.
- The total number of domestic passengers across the three airports was 2.13 million, reaching 109% year-on-year.
- International cargo flight movements stood at 102% year-on-year, and the volume of international cargo handled also reached 102%.

KIX / ITAMI / KOBE 2025H1 Traffic Report (January-June)

Movements of KIX, ITAMI, and KOBE

The number of international passenger flight movements at KIX reached 72,740, marking a record high for the first half of a calendar year and representing a 23% increase compared to the previous year. Meanwhile, international cargo flight movements totaled 8,543, and domestic flight movements across the three airports amounted to 107,407, both slightly below the figures from the previous year. **At KOBE, where international charter flights commenced in April 2025, the total number of movements was 17,544, setting a record high for the first half of a calendar year.**

Passenger numbers at KIX, ITAMI and KOBE

The number of foreign passengers at KIX reached 10.96 million, setting a record for the first half of a calendar year*1, and the total number of international passengers was 13.57 million, also marking a record. Domestic passenger numbers across the three airports was 106% year-on-year. Meanwhile, **the total number of passengers at KOBE, where international charter flights were launched, reached 1.88 million, a record high for the first half of a calendar year*2.**

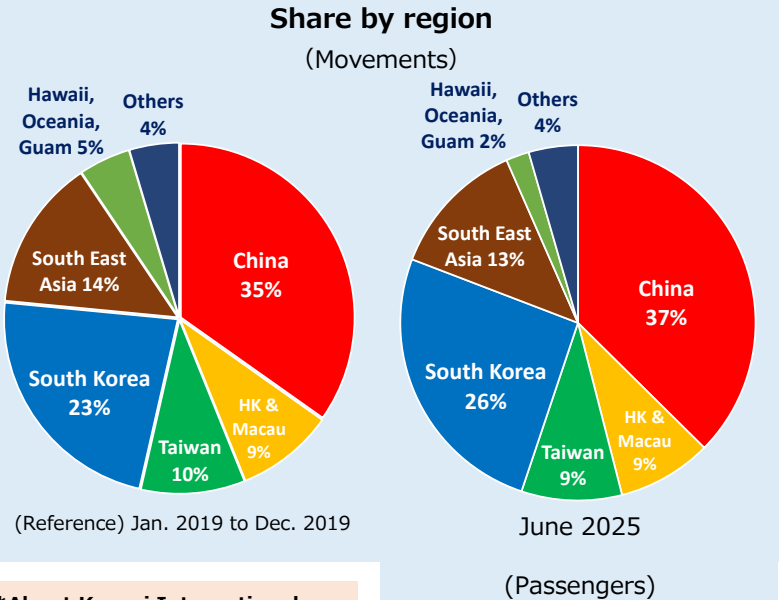

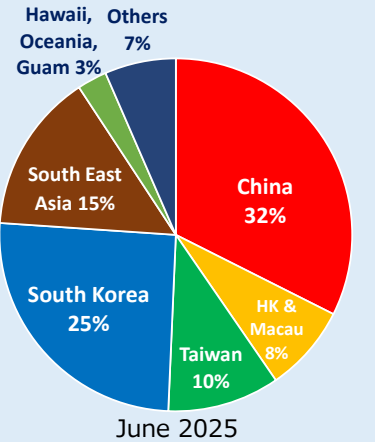
